Can you create your own artistic pattern?</p>
<p>Interview a family member about a holiday. Where did they go? What did they see? What amazed them the most?</p>	<p>Draw an accurate map of a place you can visit or that you know really well. Can you use symbols to represent different features?</p>	<p>Build a city or create a plan of one. Think about what needs to be in the centre and how you will organise your streets.</p>
<p>Go on a walk with someone from your family. Look for different habitats. Can you take photos or create a short film about them?</p>	<p>As we are looking at 'The Greatest Showman', hold a film night at home for a different film. Write invites and write a review of the film itself.</p>	<p>Design a new game which requires team work.</p>
