## What we expect of our families...



## We reward good attendance but we also challenge poor attendance

Identifying poor attendance	• Children's attendance falls below 90%. The school puts the child on an attendance action plan (children who are persistent absentees from the previous academic year begin the new school year on an attendance action plan).
Stage 1	<ul> <li>Attendance has not improved once on an action plan.</li> <li>Parent of child asked to attend a meeting with attendance leader and one other member of the attendance team.</li> <li>Targets are established and support is put in place by the school.</li> </ul>
Stage 2	<ul> <li>Targets from the previous meeting are not achieved</li> <li>Parent of child asked to attend meeting with attendance leader and a colleague from another BDAT school or governor or health professional</li> <li>Targets are established</li> </ul>
Stage 3	<ul> <li>Targets from the previous meeting are not achieved</li> <li>We will refer the case to the Educational Social Worker</li> <li>Steps will be put in place aimed at avoiding prosecution</li> <li>Prosecution may occur if failure to meet targets despite support offered</li> </ul>
