

Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

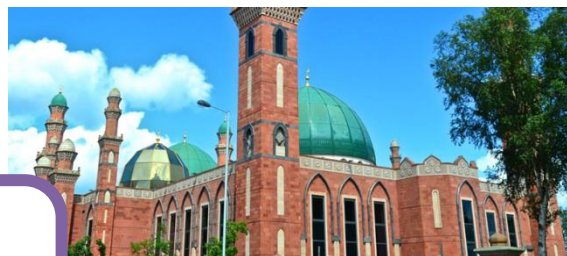

We will understand what God Muslims worship to and their bible called the Qur'an. We will understand that the Muslim faith is inspired by the Prophet Muhammed who is seen as the messenger of Allah.

Shahadah	An Islamic belief and one of the five pillars of Islam
Creator	A person who brings something new into existence
Crescent moon symbol	One of the symbols of Islam
Prophet	An inspirational teacher of faith
Mosque	A place of worship and prayer for Muslims

**Key People and Figures**

<b>Allah</b>	Muslims believe to be the one God. Allah is one of 99 names that can be given to their God.
<b>Tawhid</b>	An idea about there being one God.
<b>Imam</b>	The person who leads prayers in a mosque.
<b>Prophet Muhammed</b>	The messenger of Allah.



What do Muslims believe?

Muslims believe that Allah created all things and that humans have a responsibility to care for Allah's creation.
