Features	Things that can be found in an area
Countryside	An area made up of mostly natural features like trees and fields.
Town	A location smaller than a city but bigger than a village, Shipley is a town.
Locality	A specific place that you know a lot about often where you live
World	The world is where we all live it looks like a huge ball in space.
Observations	Things you see yourself.


