#### **Attendance**

We continue to work tirelessly as a school to further improve our attendance. This year, overall school attendance has been only 92%. The Government's expectation is 97%.

Sadly, there were some children who ended the year on the persistent absentee list, meaning they have missed more than one day out of every ten, and this will have had a significant impact on their learning. We will be closely monitoring these children's attendance, so they do not miss as much learning next year.

We have had far too many lates this academic year, with 46 children being late more than 5 times over the year. We will be monitoring families closely and arranging meetings for any that we are concerned about.

Please remember our school is always here to help. We work as hard as we can to make sure all children's needs are met. However, if you feel you would like some advice or support from us in school, please feel free to make an appointment with your child's class teacher or another relevant member of staff. Our school always aims to help and if it is possible for us to do so, we will do as much as we can.
