Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Industrial action for Teaching Staff – please read

The National Education Union (NEU) confirmed that its members will be striking over pay and conditions, and school funding on two further days. I am writing to reassure you about what this means and how it will impact your child.

Currently, strikes that will impact our academy are scheduled to take place on **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April** and **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May**. School will therefore be **closed** to all pupils except the following: -

- Vulnerable pupils and children of critical workers (we will prioritise emergency services) however numbers are limited. If you believe that you fall into one of these categories and
  would like your child to attend on the dates of industrial action, please contact the school
  as soon as possible via SchoolPing, telephone, email or in person (please do not use Class
  Dojo for this purpose).
- Some Year 6 pupils who will be contacted individually.

You will appreciate that we require an urgent response so that we can plan effectively and would appreciate it if you could let us know by <u>Tuesday at 4pm</u> so that we can make safe arrangements.
