Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your support over the last few days. As promised, I am writing to update you. We wrote to you on Monday to confirm the presence of RAAC at Christ Church. Since then, I am pleased to confirm that we have made good progress. The areas effected by RAAC have all now been identified and we have isolated these areas so that they cannot be entered by anyone in school.

Our aim was to make sure that all children return to face to face teaching by Monday 11th September and I am delighted to let you know that we now have plans in place to allow this to happen safely for all of our pupils. These are short term measures for the next few weeks whilst we look at longer term solutions. The arrangements made are as follows:

Class	Arrangements
Nursesey	This class is unaffected and will carry on as normal
Reception	This class is unaffected and will carry on as normal
Year 1 and 2	<p>KS1 Will be taught in rooms based at Shipley C of E Primary School (part of BDAT). We are very fortunate that they are able to give us a small building on their site to use. Pupils will be taught in their own (a room for year 1 and a room for year 2 with its own toilet facilities).</p> <p>These children will be taught by their normal teachers and support staff.</p> <p>Children should arrive at Christ Church at 8.50am each morning, where a coach will be waiting for them. Our staff will take them on the coach to Shipley C of E. We will bring them back to school on the coach and they will be ready for pick up at 3.20pm</p>
Year 3 and 4	<p>We have adapted existing rooms in the top corridor of school. These are not affected by RAAC. We have moved all of their classroom items into them so that the children feel comfortable.</p> <p>Children will be met at the normal place outside the KS2 entrance and teachers will walk them around to their classrooms. Pupils should arrive at the normal time of 8.50am and be collected at the normal time of 3.20pm</p> <p>These children will be taught by their normal teachers</p>

	and support staff.
Year 5 and 6	Children will continue to be taught in the hall as they have been today. These children will be taught by their normal teachers and support staff.
Nurture	Nurture will take place as usual but has now moved to the school bungalow. These children will be taught by their normal teachers and support staff.
Jelly Beans before and after school club	Jelly Beans will start again on Thursday 7.9.23 and will be based in the bungalow. The children will be taught by their normal teachers and support staff.

Once again to reiterate, these are short term measures whilst we organise longer term solutions. We hope to provide further information by the end of next week.
